Reviewer Reports

Reviewer 1	
Grade	B - This paper is acceptable. Minor improvements can be done in terms of organization/language/literature review etc. Some further comments are given below.

Comment	The authors need to describe the interviewing survey, provide the sample size, the way the interview questions were structured, how the interviews were assessed, A summary of the interview answers would enrich the evidence based on which the results were found and will support the methodology that was used.
Reviewer 2	
Grade	F - This paper should not be accepted. The reasons are as follows.
Comment	Although the paper is interesting there are some serious flaws. The most serious one is described below. This paper's methodology is not properly described, it is not clearly stated how the selection of papers was done in the literature review, also the literature review needs to be extended with more papers, now there are very few. Sustainable supply chains are a hot topic so there should be a lot of papers out there that can be checked. Even if the paper is looking at the Java case it needs to be put in an international context. Maybe there are some studies performed in other parts of the world that are valuable for this study? I suggest further work to be done and to submit to next year's conference.
Reviewer 3	
Grade	D - This paper needs a major revision before acceptance can be considered. In particular, the authors need to consider the following comments
Comment	The paper is clearly written and meets the formatting guidelines. Some more care can be taken to improve the language used in places. The topic is interesting and will be of value to the conference audience. There is a lack of engagement with the existing theory on SCM sustainability and operational practices. At present the study is an ungrounded observation of the existing practices. It would be greatly improved by using the existing frameworks to explore the cases and may show some interesting contradictions as the process is essentially wood-based and so should exhibit high levels of sustainability over other processes.
Reviewer 4	
Grade	B - This paper is acceptable. Minor improvements can be done in terms of organization/language/literature review etc. Some further comments are given below.
Comment	The paper is written in good English and has no major errors. The caption of figure 1 should be on one page together with the picture. However, the scientific approach of the paper is not entirely clear. The industrial ecosystem in traditional shipyard has been studied through interviews, but how the improvements were derived is not fully explained.

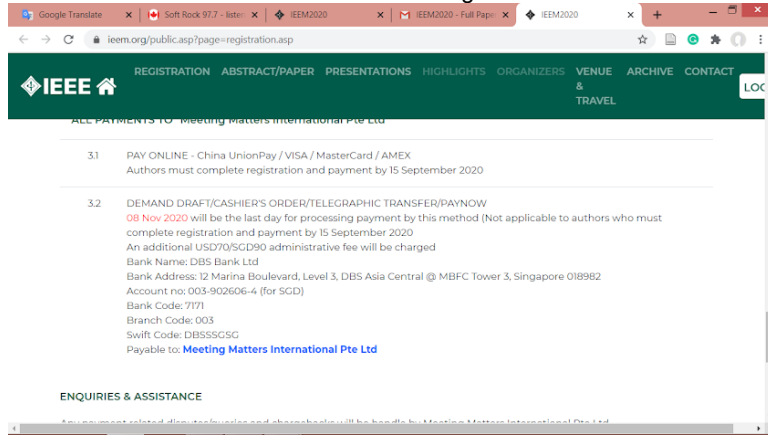
